„Successful Scientific Writing in English“

For a German or German-speaking researcher the first chosen path to getting published is usually with a German-based journal. However, publishing solely in your own language is not something you should confine your scholarly work to. It is strongly recommended to also publish in international journals if you want your research to be acknowledged by the international scientific community. If you check your field's well-known researchers' publications, you will realize that most of them have also published in English. But what is there to consider with English publications? How do English-based journals differ from the requirements of German-based journals? Many researchers do not inform themselves properly and assume that it will be sufficient to simply translate their work more or less well into English. However, several aspects have to be considered before you submit your English paper to an international or English-based journal.
