PRESENTING IN ENGLISH IN THE ACADEMIC CONTEXT

If you want to successfully establish yourself as an acknowledged researcher, it will be beneficial to present your research at international conferences. When designing a presentation or a speech in English, it helps to consider some basic rules.

Non-native speakers of English often make mistakes when translating complicated terminology into English. Moreover, presenting in English might be a challenge for you because you are not used to speaking freely in a language other than your own. Every non-native English speaker thus faces the danger of decreasing their presentation's quality because they are too consumed with linguistic and social aspects of their performance: pronunciation, correct use of terms and grammar, self-confident appearance despite presenting in English, etc. If you want your audience to benefit from your presentation, it matters even more that you deliver a professional speech without minimizing its quality.

Target Group: Female scientists who plan to present their research in an international context or who have already done so and wish to improve their skills or approach.

Workshop Goals: Identify your areas for growth, understand the peculiarities of English presentations and improve your own presentation and communication skills.
